

Junior Elementary Summer Homework - 2018

We have created an easy checklist for summer math practice! Weekly math practice on MobyMax is also expected for incoming 3rd graders (1 hour per week). MobyMax is available all summer and is great for staying sharp in all areas. Contact the school if your child does not have access.

1st Grade

Money

- Identify the name and value of a penny, nickel, dime, quarter

Mathematic Vocabulary

- Greater than and less than
- Taller/shorter, bigger/smaller and equal to

Number Sense

- Count items and write numbers
- Identify which digit is in the units place (ones) and which is in the tens place
- Play games asking questions, such as, "How many units are in 25?"

2nd Grade

Money

- Review the name and value of a penny, nickel, dime, and quarter
- Count pennies by quantity
- Count nickels (up to a dollar)
- Count dimes (up to a dollar)
- Counting quarters. (up to a dollar)

Number Sense

- Identify the value of individual digits in a number (what is the value of "2" in 25?)
- Play number games, such as, "If the number 123 was 100 more, what number would it be?"

Facts

- Memorize all numbers that add up to 10 (1+9, 2+8 etc.)
- Know addition facts 1+ through 10+

3rd Grade

Money

- Review the name and value of a penny, nickel, dime, and quarter.
- Review counting nickels dimes, and quarters

Measurement

- Read times (hour, half hour) [The app Jungle Time can assist with this.]

Facts

- Memorize all numbers that add up to 10
- Know addition and subtraction facts 1-10

Number Sense

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- [] Identify the value of individual digits in a number (what is the value of "2" in 125?)
- [] Play games like, "If the number 3,123 was 100 more, what number would it be?"

Read Read Read - Become an avid reader! Go beyond what is expected!

Pick age appropriate books – fiction and non-fiction. Complete the reading log and bring it on the first day of school, August 7th!

- 1st graders: 100 pages read independently or shared reading
- 2nd graders: 200 pages
- 3rd graders: 300 pages
